

National Child Labor School

National Child Labor Project (NCLP) is supported by Govt. implemented in Nizamabad. The objective is to eradicate child labor. This project is implemented at Bathukammakunta to mainstream child labor into regular education. Currently the project is running with 50 students and 3 teachers. Each child is paid a stipend of 150/per month.
